Tyer: Nick Sliwdanich
Pattern: Elk Hair Caddis
Hook: Standard dry fly #12-18

Thread: 6/0, brown, or colour to match body

Body: Tan or light brown synthetic or fine fur dubbing.

I like Superfine

Hackle: Brown saddle or cock dry fly cape Ribbing: (optional) extra fine copper of gold wire

Wing: Light or natural grey elk hair **Pattern:** Deer Hair Paradrake

Hook: Standard dry fly #12

Thread: 3/0, or 6/0, yellow/light green thread Tail: Moose mane or black dyed deer hair Wing: Grey deer or elk hair, natural or dyed

Body: Green dyed deer or elk hair Hackle: Olive dyed grizzly hackle

*clear head cement is used when finishing this fly
