**Hook:** Mustad 94833 #16 and #18

Thread: Yellow 6/0 or 8/0
Tail: Yellow dry hackle
Rib: Fine gold wire
Body: Natural color dubbing

Wingcase: Yellow CDC

Legs: Yellow wood duck or imitation

**Head:** Natural dubbing

Pattern: *PMD CDC Boit Spinner*Hook: Mustad 94833 #16 and #18

Thread: Yellow 6/0 or 8/0
Tail: Dun mico-fibbets
Body: Yellow goose biots
Thorax: Natural color dubbing

**Legs:** Yellow wood duck or imitation

**Head:** Natural dubbing

**Comments:** *Mike will tie as many of patterns as time allows.* 

Tyer: Dave Murray
Pattern: Black Nosed Dace
Hook: Mustad 38941 3xl std
Thread: Black 6/0 or 140 Unithread
Tag: Very short red wool

**Rib:** Oval silver tinsel **Body:** Flat medium tinsel

Wings: 3 layers of bucktail, white bottom, black middle

(3/4 length), natural brown top

**Hook:** #14 Mustad 98440 or Tiemco 100

**Bead:** Small pearlescent

**Rib:** 1 strand pearlescent krystal flash **Body:** 6 strands green embroidery thread

Collar: Brown soft hackle

Pattern: *Pheasant Tail Soft Hackle*Hook: #14 Mustad 98440 or Tiemco 100

Bead: Small pearlescent
Tail: Pheasant tail fibres
Rib: Copper Wire
Collar: Brown soft hackle
