Hook: Mustad 3799 Sizes #2 to #6

Thread: Black 6/0

Body: Polypropylene Yarn (yellow, olive or brown)

Legs: Hen hackle fibres

Eyes. Twisted polypropylene yarn

Comments: Rick will tie both the darner and crawler versions of this pattern. They are supposed to be very simple and quick to tie.
