Thread: Black 6/0

Material: Saltwater hair, bucktail, saddle hackles,

peacock herl and crystal flash

Comments: Les will demonstrate how to tie up those salmon and pike patterns that have epoxy bodies and heads. Material list is generic, as long as it's colorful.

Tyer: Dave Phelps
Pattern: Evil Weevil
Thread: UTC 140 Olive

Hook #10/#14 Tiemco 2457 caddis/shrimp

Bead: Gold 1/8" Tungsten
Tail: Rabbit guard hairs
Body: Light green caddis dub
Thorax: Dark green peacock dub
Overbody/wing case: Salt water mylar

Pattern: Green Spratley

Thread 6/0 black or olive
Hook: #10 – 4x ring eye nymph
Tail: Dyed olive guinea hen

Rib: Green holographic tinsel, medium

Body: Wool (peacock herl color)
Throat: Dyed olive guinea hen
Downwing: Olive pheasant rump
Head: Peacock herl

Comments: Dave will demonstrate two of the most productive patterns for fishing local ponds and streams. The evil weevil is developing quite a reputation for Rockie attraction and the Spratley for fooling trout on Hasse Lake.
