Featured in books and outdoor magazines, he has become well known throughout the country as an expert on fly fishing in the West. Jack lectures in the wintertime (when he's not fishing New Zealand), throughout North America, on fly fishing methods and his favorite subject, fishing in Jackson Hole.
