Jack is well known for his western fly patterns and has written various books on the subject. His first book written in 1974 is a wonderful book and soon became the standard for us in the Rockies. Featured in books and outdoor magazines, he has become well known throughout the country as an expert on fly fishing in the West. Jack lectures in the winter-time (when he's not fishing New Zealand), throughout North America, on fly fishing methods and his favorite subject, fishing in Jackson Hole. He lives in Jackson Hole and is one of Wyoming's best known fishing guides. Jack is also the creator of the famous Jackson Hole One Fly event.

His fly tying books are:

- *Western Trout Fly Tying Manual Vol. 1*
- *Western Trout Fly Tying Manual Vol. 11*
- *Tying Flies (Jack Dennis and Friends)*

He has also produced numerous fly fishing videos on fly tying, fly fishing and fly fishing tips (The Traveling Fly Fishermen) with well known Henry's Fork angler *Mike Lawson* and Nymph expert *Gary LaFontaine*. I first met Jack some twelve years ago where he introduced me to the Humpty. Jack will give several presentations daily at the Sportsmen's Show, you will find him at The Fishing Hole in Hall C, Booth C11.

Tier : Tak Shimizu

For these flies please bring your own thread and gloss

1. GREY HERON

Hook: Low water salmon #2
Thread: Black 6/0
Body: Rear third: Lemon floss. // Front two thirds: Black seal's fur
Rib: Medium flat silver tinsel followed by fine oval silver tinsel (5 turns)
Hackle: Grey Heron substitute from the second turn of tinsel
Throat Hackle: Guinea Hen (2 turns)
Wing: Bronze Mallard strips

MARCH 12TH

Tier : Michael Dell mdell@freenet.edmonton.ab.ca

For these flies please bring the following-:

1. COPPERHEAD

Hook: Any nymph hook (Any size)
Thread: Copper wire (medium for large, fine for small)
Body: Fur or any course dubbing

* This fly is known for taking large browns, and is similar to the Sawyer series, need I say more.

MARCH 19TH

Tier : Ian Denny flytying@telusplanet.net

For these flies please bring the following-:

1. CAREY SPECIAL

Hook: Nymph 4XL (sizes 6 - 12)
Thread: Black 6/0
Tail: Black bear hair
Body: 6 strands of long black bear hair (or substitute)
Hackle: Ringed-neck cock pheasant rust rump feather, doubled

* One of my secrets "when in doubt lead with a Carey"

MARCH 26TH

Tier : Michael Heemskerk

For these flies please bring the following-:

1. STIMULATOR ORANGE

Hook: Talon ST163C, sizes 6 - 14
Thread: Orange
Tail: Elk hair
Body: Fluorescent orange antron yarn
Rib: Gold wire
Body hackle: Brown, palmered
Wing: Elk hair
Thorax: Yellow dubbing
Hackle: Grizzly, through thorax

* Good Southern Alberta pattern. In larger sizes it produces during the giant stonefly hatch throughout the west
