	Grey Ostrich Herl.
	Natural Grizzly Neck (Size 10).
	Yellow Grizzly Neck (Size 10).

Imitates the hymph stage of the Golden Stonefly (Acrneuria Pacifica).

Hook:	Nymph or streamer hook, 3x long, size 6 to 10. Suggest Mustad 9672, Dai-Riki 710, or Tiemco 5263.
Thread:	Uni-Thread 6/0, dark brown or camel.
.ght:	.025 or .030 lead wire, 15 to 20 wraps doubled back over thorax area.
Tails:	Goose biots, dyed golden brown or yellow.
Rib:	Larva Lace nymph rib brown, or Swannundaze #80.
Wingcase & Overbody:	Turkey wing segment treated with Dave's Flexament.
Abdomen:	Dubbing - my preference is a mixture of 3 types of Great Canadian Dubbing colours: 50% Antron Golden Stone, 40% Antron Cinnamon Caddis, 10% Antron Dark Stone, or Scintilla #64, or Great Canadian Golden Stone Blend.
Thorax:	Same as abdomen - use a dubbing loop for a thicker / fuller effect.

B.H.P.T. Midge Larvae

Hook:	Pupa Fly curved shank, Sizes 14 to 20. Suggest Tiemco 2487 or 2457, Mustad 80250BR or 80200BR, Daichi 1130.
Thread:	Uni-Thread 8/0, or 12/0, colour to suit.
Bead:	Glass or metal, extra small, gold or copper.
Rib:	Extra fine wire, gold, silver, or copper.
<u>y:</u>	Pheasant tail fibers, natural, black, olive or red.
Thorax:	Peacock herl.

Dragon Fly Nymph



Imitates the nymph stage of the Dragon Fly (Odonata Asisoptem).

Hook:	Streamer hook, 4x long, size 4 to 6. Suggest Mustad 79580, or Dai-Riki 700.
Thread:	Monochord 3/0, or Uni-Thread 6/0 olive.
Weight:	.025 or .030 lead wire, 15 to 20 wraps over front 1/2 of hook shank.
Eyes:	30 lb test black monofilament with ends melted.
Tail:	Olive dyed marabou tied 1/3 to 1/2 hook shank.
Rib:	Medium or heavy copper wire.
Underbody:	Black or olive wool to give robust shape.
Legs:	Pheasant tail fibers 6 - 8 fibers tied in at each side of the body.
Wingcase:	Butt ends of pheasant tail fibre legs.
Thorax:	Same as body.

Stone Hopper

Imitates adult golden stoneflies and grasshoppers.

Hook:	Dry Fly, fine wire, 2x long sizes 6 to 10. Suggest Mustad 94831, Tiernco 5212, or Dai-Riki 730.	
Thread:	Uni-Thread 6/0 yellow, or colour to suit.	
Rib:	Brown dry fly hackle 2 sizes undersized.	
Tail:	Dyed yellow elk hair or deer hair.	
Body:	Same as tail.	
Underwing:	(Optional) small amount of pearlescent Kyrstal Flash.	
Wing:	Natural elk hair.	
Head:	Elk or deer hair dyed yellow tied bullet style.	
Legs:	(Optional) Round rubber hackle tied in at each side. White or colour to suit.

Rear Hook:	Tiemco 101 #14 - #16
Front Hook:	Mustad 9671 #12 - #14
Thread:	6/0 - 8/0 tying thread.
Hinge:	Monofilament or heavy tying thread.
Weight:	0.015 lead or lead substitute.
Tail:	Mallard Flank feather fibers.
Beard:	Mallard Flank feather fibers.
Wingcase:	Mottled turkey quill.
Abdomen:	Light brown dubbing.
Thorax:	Med. to Dark brown dubbing.



Thread:	6/0 - 8/0 tying thread.
Tail:	Moose body hair.
Body:	Peacock herl & red floss.

Hackle:	Brown or Coachman Brown.

Thread:	6/0 Olive.
Bead:	Glass or metal, extra small, gold or copper.
Eyes:	Lead or nickel plated dumbbell eyes.
Wing:	Chartreuse bucktail on the bottom. Olive bucktail on the top with Holographic flash mixed in.


X-Caddis

Hook:	Dry Fly (eg. Daiichi 1190, Tiemco 100), sizes 10-16.
Thread:	8/0 Olive.
- ail:	Olive antron yarn.
Body:	Olive antron dubbing.
Wing:	Natural deer hair.

Magic Stone

Hook:	Curved nymph (eg. Tiemco 200R, Talon ST163C), Sizes 6-10.
Thread:	8/0, Brown or black.
Tails:	Two brown goose biots, tied split.
Overbody:	Medium brown marabou fibers.
Abdomen:	Kauffman's Blends, golden stone.
Rib:	Medium copper wire.
Thorax:	Gold Lite Brite dubbing.
Wing Case:	Remainder of marabou pulled forward over thorax.
Hackle:	Brown hen saddle, tied soft hackle style.
Head:	Brass bead, size to match hook.

Hook:	Nymph or streamer hook, 3x long, size 6 to 10. Suggest Mustad 9672, Dai-Riki 710, or Tiemco 5263.
Thread:	Uni-Thread 6/0, dark brown or camel.
.ght:	.025 or .030 lead wire, 15 to 20 wraps doubled back over thorax area.
Tails:	Goose biots, dyed golden brown or yellow.
Rib:	Larva Lace nymph rib brown, or Swannundaze #80.
Wingcase & Overbody:	Turkey wing segment treated with Dave's Flexament.
Abdomen:	Dubbing - my preference is a mixture of 3 types of Great Canadian Dubbing colours: 50% Antron Golden Stone, 40% Antron Cinnamon Caddis, 10% Antron Dark Stone, or Scintilla #64, or Great Canadian Golden Stone Blend.
Thorax:	Same as abdomen - use a dubbing loop for a thicker / fuller effect.

Hook:	Pupa Fly curved shank, Sizes 14 to 20. Suggest Tiemco 2487 or 2457, Mustad 80250BR or 80200BR, Daichi 1130.
Thread:	Uni-Thread 8/0, or 12/0, colour to suit.
Bead:	Glass or metal, extra small, gold or copper.
Rib:	Extra fine wire, gold, silver, or copper.
y:	Pheasant tail fibers, natural, black, olive or red.
Thorax:	Peacock herl.

Dragon Fly Nymph



Imitates the nymph stage of the Dragon Fly (Odonata Asisoptern).

Hook:	Streamer hook, 4x long, size 4 to 6. Suggest Mustad 79580, or Dai-Riki 700.
Thread:	Monochord 3/0, or Uni-Thread 6/0 olive.
Weight:	.025 or .030 lead wire, 15 to 20 wraps over front 1/2 of hook shank.
Eyes:	30 lb test black monofilament with ends melted.
Tail:	Olive dyed marabou tied 1/3 to 1/2 hook shank.
Rib:	Medium or heavy copper wire.
Underbody:	Black or olive wool to give robust shape.
Legs:	Pheasant tail fibers 6 - 8 fibers tied in at each side of the body.
Wingcase:	Butt ends of pheasant tail fibre legs.
Thorax:	Same as body.

Stone Hopper

Imitates adult golden stoneflies and grasshoppers.

Hook:	Dry Fly, fine wire, 2x long sizes 6 to 10. Suggest Mustad 94831, Tiemco 5212, or Dai-Riki 730.	
Thread:	Uni-Thread 6/0 yellow, or colour to suit.	
Rib:	Brown dry fly hackle 2 sizes undersized.	
Tail:	Dyed yellow elk hair or deer hair.	
Body:	Same as tail.	
Underwing:	(Optional) small amount of pearlescent Kyrstal Flash.	
Wing:	Natural elk hair.	
Head:	Elk or deer hair dyed yellow tied bullet style.	
Legs:	(Optional) Round rubber hackle tied in at each side. White or colour to suit.



Wing:	Chartreuse bucktail on the bottom. Olive bucktail on the top with Holographic flash mixed in.

X-Caddis

Hook:	Dry Fly (eg. Daiichi 1190, Tiemco 100), sizes 10-16.
Thread:	8/0 Olive.
_ail:	Olive antron yarn.
Body:	Olive antron dubbing.
Wing:	Natural deer hair.

Magic Stone

Hook:	Curved nymph (eg. Tiemco 200R, Talon ST163C), Sizes 6-10.
Thread:	8/0, Brown or black.
Tails:	Two brown goose biots, tied split.
Overbody:	Medium brown marabou fibers.
Abdomen:	Kauffman's Blends, golden stone.
Rib:	Medium copper wire.
Thorax:	Gold Lite Brite dubbing.
Wing Case:	Remainder of marabou pulled forward over thorax.
Hackle:	Brown hen saddle, tied soft hackle style.
Head:	Brass bead, size to match hook.
