## TIPS OF THE MONTH

A rotary fabric cutter and a steel straight edge make wonderful tools for cutting foam into thin strips. Just don't let the family sewer catch you using the cutter.

Empty clear film cans make secure hook storage containers. They're even water proof!

Check Wal-Mart for foam sheets-most colours less than \$1 for 12x16 sheet
