Mustad 9671 Size 2 Salmon hook or Size 2 Hook:

streamer hook

6/0 brown Superthread Thread

Ring neck Pheasant breast feather Tail

Rib fine Copper wire

Dubbing mix of creamy white and pink Body Dark Brown Squirrel tail topper lighter brown Wing

Squirrel mixed with pale yellow buck tail if time

Pattern: **Muddler Minnow**

Hook: size 8 or 10 Mustad 9672 3 x long

Thread: Brown 6/0

Mottled turkey quill fibers Tail:

Silver tinsel Body:

Wing: Brown bear hair mixed with white hair Head: Natural Deer body hair tied as bullet head
