Dismal Creek Grayling Blitz - May 30th

Thanks to Ken Monk and Jim O'Neil's planning and organization skills, a good start to our club's participation in the 2015 volunteer angling survey in the Pembina River Watershed took place Saturday. We gathered at the Spruce Grove Tim Horton's and after receiving final instructions the "Fisher's & Tagger's" headed out to their designated locations on Dismal Creek shortly after 8:00 A.M. There were 7 teams consisting of 3 persons each, club members, Golder Associates, and ESRD biologists participated. At last count 47 grayling were caught. Several **Rocky Mountain Whites** were also landed. Most of the grayling caught that were over 20 cm were tagged and fin samples were taken. A grand daddy of a grayling, just under 17 inches, was caught by **Mike Blackburn**, way to go Mike. Keep an eye on the club forum for stories and pictures as well as upcoming outings. Thanks to all who participated in this very worthwhile conservation data gathering project.
